



Maritime On-Line[®] NOA/D On-Line

Overview

The Notice of Arrival/Departure (NOA/D) On-Line provides the shipping community with an automated tool to submit advanced vessel arrival and departure notices, including crew list information, to those federal agencies which require the information. Through a single and standardized web interface, filers have the capability to submit notice of arrivals and departures to the U.S. Coast Guard National Vessel Movement Center (NVMC) and U.S. Customs and Border Protection. The system tracks these notices electronically and includes the ability to respond to senders with confirmations and other necessary information.

Building on previous submission methods, NOA/D On-Line provides a mechanism for vessel masters and their landside partners to submit the required notice of arrival and departure information in the required XML format via a combination of MS Excel Spreadsheet and web site review.

Filers can submit NOA/Ds via an Excel spreadsheet to their landside partner for submission to NOA/D On-Line. NOA/D On-Line makes the data submitted available to the steamship community via web interface for review and submission. Once validated by the steamship agent community, the XML data is transmitted to the NVMC.

If preferred, the filer can key the information directly into the web portal.

Maritime On-Line Features

The MOL system integrates NOA/D, Ship Reporting, TRACS, and AIS into a single portal for user access. Through the same log-in account, subscribers can switch between each module allowing data input or review of the same vessel for all modules.

Notice of Arrival Features

NOA/D Online is available on the web and includes many operational features to help streamline the Arrival and Departure Notice submission process.

- Filers can enter data in an optional MS Excel Spreadsheet or key data directly into the portal
- Landside partners can review the data via the web portal before submitting
- Responses from USCG of receipt of NOA/D are immediate
- The system includes a copy data feature to streamline updates, notices of departure, filings at subsequent U.S. port calls and repeat voyages
- Error checking helps minimize the submission of invalid or missing data
