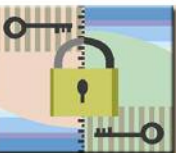
ELECTRONIC MANIFEST FILING

TRACS is the community-based cargo release module to submit ocean import manifest information to U.S. Customs and Border Protection.

-  TRACS streamlines manifest submissions through simple on-line data entry and powerful import functionality - you choose the best input method for your needs
-  With fewer screens and an intuitive, easy to learn interface, you spend less time on data entry and more time serving your customers
-  Manifests and status messages are automatically shared electronically with trading partners to reduce phone calls, emails . . . and more importantly, to speed up cargo delivery

TRACS was developed and is maintained by maritime professionals who understand the business.

- ◆ The Maritime Exchange, a non-profit trade association representing commercial maritime businesses, has been processing electronic manifests for the port industry since 1988
- ◆ The system was developed in cooperation with the port community - people like you who know what they need in a manifest system
- ◆ TRACS remains fully compliant with emerging CBP requirements to help ensure your cargo moves as quickly as possible to its final destination
- ◆ The Maritime Exchange monitors CBP regulations and procedural changes that affect filers, freeing up your time to focus on your business

- ◆ Fully web-based system provides access to TRACS from virtually anywhere, anytime
- ◆ Copy features reduce rekeying of duplicate data within a manifest
- ◆ Streamlined functions facilitate moving and copying bills of lading to other ports of discharge or other manifests without rekeying
- ◆ Manifest upload feature allows you to import data from your system directly into TRACS to further reduce data entry

SECURITY FILING & STOW PLAN COMPLIANT (10+2)

- ◆ File required Inbond and FROB data to meet Advanced Security Filing Requirements (ISF-5)
- ◆ Enter or upload Stow Plan information for all containers to meet federal reporting requirements
- ◆ ISF-5 and Stow Plan are integrated with the manifest to reduce redundant data entry

STATUS REVIEW AND REPORTS

- ◆ Searchable online and printable status review at your fingertips
- ◆ Comprehensive reports detail all activity, history, and statuses associated with your bills of lading

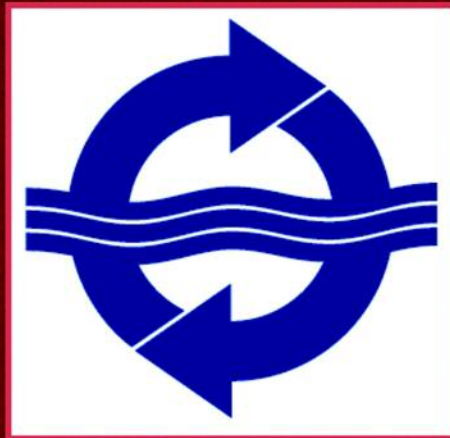
