**SAFETY ADVISORY FOR VESSELS TRANSITING THE DELAWARE RIVER,
CHESTER RANGE**

The Captain of the Port Sector Delaware Bay advises all port operators and vessels transiting the Delaware River, Chester Range of electrical work being conducted over the river reducing the air draft to 170 feet.

Between the hours of 0700 and 1700 until approximately the 21st of November 2008, the vessel "Night Life" will be working with PECO to replace electrical wires over the Delaware River, Chester Range. Vessels wishing to transit the Chester Range during this time should contact the vessel "Night Life" on CH 13 VHF/FM with an ETA and air draft in order for work to be secured and sufficient air draft provided.
