SUBJECT: Public Notice of Changes to Vehicle Export Processing

Commencing on August 5<sup>th</sup> 2018, the Port of Philadelphia will no longer require copies of the photo identification of a vehicles registered owner to be submitted prior to a vehicles export. Exporters will still be required to submit proper validation paperwork to include: an original title or manufactures statement or origin, an original bill of sale, a signed dock receipt, a cover letter detailing the export particulars with contact information and at least one photocopy of each. This information must be submitted to Customs and Border Protection (CBP) at least 72 hours prior to export to allow time for processing and exam.

Exporters may be asked by CBP to provide additional documentation, including a copy of the owners photo identification, before the vehicle can be approved for export.
