Completion of Marcus Hook Range Dredging Operations

The Dredge PULLEN has completed operations within the Marcus Hook Range. The U.S. Coast Guard has cleared the safety zone within Marcus Hook Range in the Delaware River on November 10, 2010.

Vessels desiring to anchor within the Marcus Hook Anchorage are no longer required to obtain permission from the Captain of the Port. Mariners are reminded that with the exception of Anchorage A, no vessel shall occupy any prescribed anchorage for a longer period than 48 hours without a permit from the Captain of the Port. Vessels expecting to be at anchor for more than 48 hours shall obtain a permit from the Captain of the Port for that purpose.
