---

### MOL SUMMARY

---

Maritime On-Line® (MOL) integrates TRACS, Ship Reporting, NOA/D On-Line, and the Automatic Identification System in a comprehensive maritime information web portal. Through a single login account, subscribers can access a vessel's schedule, manifest data, notice of arrival/departure, and real-time position information.

### NOA/D ON-LINE SUMMARY

---

The notice of arrival/departure system provides the shipping community with a tool to submit advanced vessel arrival and departure notices, including crew list information, to the U.S. Coast Guard National Vessel Movement Center and U.S. Customs and Border Protection.

Filers can key the information directly into the web portal or submit NOA/Ds via an Excel spreadsheet. Users validate the data before transmitting, and the system tracks the notices electronically. It also responds to senders with error messages, confirmations, and other necessary information.

### NOA/D ON-LINE FEATURES

---

- Allows either a vessel master or local filer, such as a ship agent, to enter or upload the data
- Provides local partners the ability to review and validate data before submitting
- Posts immediate receipts and confirmations from the Coast Guard
- Includes a copy feature to streamline updates, notices of departure, filings at subsequent U.S. port calls, and repeat voyages
- Provides functionality to print NOA/D data and crew manifests
- Supported by Maritime Exchange staff 24 hours a day, 365 days a year
